With an increase in coronavirus cases, especially in younger demographics, the city of Jacksonville instituted a requirement for masks to be worn inside for public gatherings and where social distancing is difficult/not possible. The requirement applies to our gatherings, and we will follow the city's guidelines. As a result, this is our schedule and procedures, starting July 1<sup>st</sup>. Wednesday services will continue at 6:30 p.m., and will include the worship team gathering in the sanctuary and the adult Bible study in the Fellowship Hall. When in the building, masks are required to be worn. Sunday will see a change as we will only have one service, @ 11:00 a.m. Attendance numbers in June makes us comfortable that we will have room for those who attend while maintaining social distance guidelines. When in the building, masks are required. We will not have Community Groups until further notice. I know this is frustrating, but please help us make this work. If for whatever reason you are uncomfortable attending in person, live stream of our Sunday service begins @ 11:00 a.m.

Our students are leaving on their retreat July 12<sup>th</sup>. Please be praying for them and our leaders.
