

A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

Our current sermon series on Sunday mornings – The most important thing about me is what I think about when I think about God – has at its core spiritual growth and health. If I will evaluate what I think about God and ensure it is compatible with Scripture, my opportunities for spiritual growth and health greatly improve. I hope you have been part of this series, either in person or virtually. If you have missed one or all of them, you can find them on our YouTube channel, "holidayhillbaptist."

Spiritual growth and health are dependent on our thoughts and understandings of God, and they are also dependent on asking God to move within us. Dr. Mark Searby in his book, The Resilient Pastor, speaks to spiritual formation and gives advice on three daily prayers that can help turn our heart and mind to God's desire for us and His ability to accomplish those desires. These are prayers we simply voice to God and are open to act on in the course of our day. First: "Shape my heart" - Psalm 51:10. Ask God to massage and manipulate your heart to be as His and to desire what He desires. Second: "Renew my mind" - Romans 12:2. We often cannot grow spiritually because of how we think about life, ourselves, others, and issues/ perspectives. Such a prayer asks God to help me reprocess how I look at every area of life. Third: "Use my hands" - Colossians 3:23, 24. As God makes us more like Him in our heart and mind, the natural outflow will be to

serve both Him and others. I encourage you to use these prayers, or something like them, in your life. A day can be satisfying and full of joy when I look back on it and see that my heart desired the things of God, my mind thought healthy thoughts that honor God, and my 'hands' were used to glorify Him by helping others. That is not a bad way to live.

I really enjoy our times of worship together. The atmosphere of our services and leadership of our worship team is so uplifting. If you are with us in person, please keep coming, and invite a friend. If you are not back with us yet, please know a few things. First, when you are comfortable and ready, we look forward to seeing you again! Second, though there is no mask mandate in the building, we are still asking for masks to be worn when moving around and keeping distancing a priority for everyone's comfort. Third, though I know there are differing views on vaccinations, more and more of our people are vaccinated, which gives some people a new level of comfort. Fourth, when you do return, please bring a friend with you.


What did Justin Timberlake say on April 30? It's going to be May!.....Okay, I'll see myself out, but before I do here are a few things to know.


