

A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

I hope you are well as we exit 2022, a year in which, as usual, God blessed in many ways. We saw people come to Christ & baptized as a result of their faith commitment. We experienced growth in different ministry areas: Embers ministry (young adults), Young @ Heart ministry (senior adults), Next Generation ministry (preschool, children, students & families), MACHO93 (men) & others. Our giving in 2022 was very strong, enabling us to minister, & the stewardship team & I are so thankful for everyone's commitment to stewardship. Our relationship with our community is strong. I could go on, but you see how good God has been.

As we enter 2023, our mission & focus within that mission, stay the same: Intentionally engage the world with the love of Christ, & as we do so proclaim the Gospel, encourage people to trust Christ as Savior & follow in baptism, & to help them grow as disciples. Along with that focus & regular ministry, there are other opportunities before us. This month we begin the remodel of our fellowship hall (funded with a \$50,000 gift). In February we will begin discussing a Capital Campaign to raise funds to pay off the sanctuary mortgage & make other improvements to our facilities. We will finish the Prayer Garden (planting & fountain). I shared details @ the December 2022 business meeting of the possibility of housing a Day Care on church property. We are working with business owners for them to lease our space beginning in the late summer before school begins. We will have more

information in the days ahead & hope to formally approve the relationship in February.

Opportunities are great, but they do not produce results on their own. What will it take to embrace & capitalize on these situations? $\underline{\text{First}} \rightarrow \text{pray hard } \& \text{ seek where}$ God is moving & allow the Holy Spirit to guide. Second → ensure mission & unity are top priorities. Allow our mission to be accomplished by not standing in the way & being a barrier, but instead, joining in. Insist on unity in these ways: remember that none of us own our space, the church does, & we must allow space to be used as needed, not our desires, which might mean changes/moving locations; decide that if you are affected by moves/changes, you will not make a deal of it, but rather work to the find best spot while understanding what others need; be part of solving problems, not creating them. Third \rightarrow Handle everything w/ humility, wisdom, & maturity. If you have questions, go to the source(s) that can answer them, not rumors/gossip, & be mindful that spiritual warfare will be present.

I look forward to how God will guide & work in our church family in the months ahead. I also look forward to the individual stories of how He will work in you & your family. I know there will be difficulties & challenges, but despite them, may He be praised.
