A Word From The Pastor

And the angel said to the woman, "Do not be afraid; for I know that you are looking for Jesus who has been crucified. He is not here, for He has risen, just as He said."

Matthew 28:5, 6 (NASB, 2020)

In the coming days we celebrate what sets Christianity apart from all other belief systems, and more importantly, what constitutes eternal truth for all of humanity. Jesus – fully God and fully man – came to earth for the express reason of being the payment for my sin. My sin separates me from God's righteousness, something to which I cannot attain on my own merit. Jesus, in His love and grace did so for me – "He made Him who knew no sin to be sin in our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." (2 Corinthians 5:21, NASB 2020) When Jesus was crucified and died, He accomplished the purpose of paying my debt.

(1 Corinthians 15:55-57, NASB 2020) My faith in Christ to settle my debt is rewarded with a relationship of new life with God the Father through Him. 😊

So, what do I do with this? I allow it to change and impact the way I live until I meet Him one day. "Therefore, if you have been raised with Christ, keep seeking the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God." (Colossians 3:1, NASB 2020)
