

## A Word From the Pastor

On Sunday, January 26th, our church Lead Team, a combination of staff and ministry leaders, met to review, plan, and prepare to lead our church. We meet once per quarter and each time I ask a series of questions to gauge how they see the ministry of Holiday Hill. Following are four questions and the answers received. I was very thankful and pleased with what our leaders see God doing in His church, and I hope you will feel the same.

<u>What is the 'pulse' of the church?</u> Best 'pulse' in a while. Energy is 'kickin.' New people, more numbers, younger people. The right people are in the right spot. A variety of ministries. Attitude is good.

<u>What do we have to celebrate?</u> 'Blessing of more people, baptisms, good giving/stewardship, and buildings being updated. People coming want to find their place & help. Conversion growth.
