A Word From the Pastor

St. Patrick's Day is a special day in my family as it is my mother's birthday. My family never gave much attention to the holiday because our focus was elsewhere. However, in parts of the world and the United States, St. Patrick's Day is a big deal, which I have never understood. St. Patrick is not a well-known figure, so why give him a day?

Patrick was honestly an amazing figure. Born in Britain around 385 A.D., he was enslaved by raiders to his home at age 16 and taken to Ireland. Eventually he escaped from his captors and made it back to Britain. However, feeling led to return to Ireland, he did so at a later date, bringing with him the message of Christ, and thus bringing Christianity to Ireland. Patrick died on March 17, 461 A.D., hence the day on which he is recognized.

Patrick's story reminds us that though we might be 'enslaved' to something in our lives, we can escape, especially through Christ. His story also reminds us that when God burdens us with a calling, even if it takes us back to a place of pain, as we go obediently with Him, He will do a work we cannot imagine. In whatever way you celebrate, or do not celebrate, St. Patrick's Day, I hope on the 17th of this month you will be reminded of how God used this amazing man, and how He can and will use you, because you are amazing also. 😊

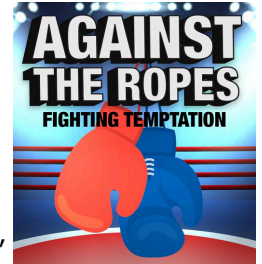

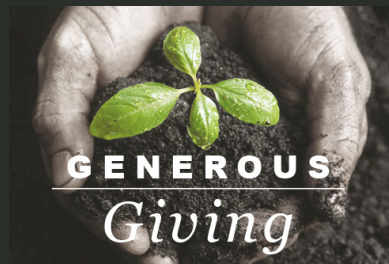
